


Without you here today, we wouldn't be able to reach people like Ruby. The music would stop.




We all know the power music has. From the emotional connection to your favourite artist, or the festivals in fields with friends – it connects us. And in the hands of our music therapists, it can be transformative.



"The dark thoughts stop when you're playing music."

Ruby has an amazing sense of humour. She's a brilliant baker, loves listening to music and playing her bass. She loves getting piercings and colouring her hair. She sounds like most teenage girls of 16.

She was 10 years old when she was diagnosed with Autism and ADHD. Growing up, every day events caused Ruby extreme emotional distress and her parents worried as her mental health become worse and worse.

A life-changing event

At the age of 14, life became so unbearable for Ruby that she was sectioned under the Mental Health Act for five months due to suicide attempts, self-harm and unpredictable behaviour. Life stood still for 8 days while her parents waited in their local hospital for a place on a specialist psychiatric children's ward. Eventually one became available in Chelmsford; 80 miles from home and a 160 mile round trip to visit.



"Your hopes and dreams for your child are taken away from you. You lose all your parental rights and strangers are suddenly making decisions on how best to care for your child." – Bev Even after Ruby returned home from hospital, she was still very unwell and it was difficult for the whole family. No treatments or therapies were helping Ruby to get better, and she struggled to engage with or trust any professionals offering support.

We had to try music therapy

Ruby's mum Bev didn't know much about music therapy or how it worked, but had read about the benefits so knew she had to try. So, Ruby started weekly sessions with Jered.

"When I first met Ruby, she had such a big personality, and I knew she just needed guidance and encouragement to show the world who she really is. The sessions gave Ruby confidence and allowed her to be silly and have fun." – Jered, music therapist.


Music therapy provided a safe space for Ruby, free from the pressure of the outside world and allowed her to express herself through music. She immediately connected with Jered and really looked forward to her sessions. She would leave each week feeling calmer, happier and uplifted - the happiest her family had seen her in a long time.

"Discovering music therapy has helped save my beautiful girl from what looked like a very difficult future, that's if she even had a future. There have been times when I thought it would all end" – Bev.
