



About Nordoff and Robbins

At Nordoff and Robbins, we're working to make sure high-quality music therapy becomes an integral part of health and social care. We believe everyone who needs it should have access to music therapy, and it's proven to improve people's quality of life.

That's because the transformational power of music therapy can evoke tears, joy, and moments of transcendent human connection.

To each unique encounter between a music therapist and the people they work with, we bring humanity, deep academic study, years of professional practice, vulnerability, courage, sensitivity, a determination to reach those who are isolated and in need, continuous learning, creative thinking, improvisation, compassion, visionary supporters, and, yes, music.

Waiting lists for young people with mental health challenges are at an all-time high. The numbers of people living with dementia are increasing and support for autistic children and those with learning difficulties is becoming inadequate. With millions of people impacted, we know music, as a health intervention, can help.

But we can't do this without you, our biggest advocates. You understand the power of music to bring people together, and from our first O_2 Silver Clef Awards in 1976, to the Knebworth concert in 1990, right through to today – the music industry has been at the heart of Nordoff and Robbins and the people we help.

Last year alone we reached 16,979 people with 54,654 music therapy sessions and worked with 391 organisations including care homes, schools and hospitals. And there are so many more people to reach. It costs £8.1 million per year to carry out our life-changing work and we receive no direct government funding. This means we rely entirely on the generosity of people like you and events like tonight to keep our work going.

By being here, you're doing far more than celebrating the incredible artists who inspire millions around the world. You're directly funding the music therapy that brings connection, hope and transformation to people who need it most. But our work doesn't stop there. Alongside delivering music therapy, we train the next generation of music therapists and drive pioneering research to amplify the impact of this extraordinary practice.

Tonight, your support doesn't just make a difference, it makes all the difference. Thank you for standing with us and ensuring we can continue changing lives through the power of music.





Poppy's Story

Poppy is three years old and lives with Rett Syndrome.

Poppy's early years were happy and full of joy and discovery. Her parents watched with excitement and love as she reached each milestone – her tiny hand holding on to theirs, her first sounds, her first wobbly steps.

But then, things changed. Poppy stopped babbling. She stopped crawling and walking. She became withdrawn and frustrated. The next few months were overwhelming, full of specialist visits and tests as they tried to find answers.

"No one could tell us what was wrong. Every day was a step further into the unknown. And every step felt heavier than the last." Rhiannon, Poppy's Mum

A shocking diagnosis

After 12 months of uncertainty, Poppy was diagnosed with Rett Syndrome – a rare, neurodevelopmental disorder caused by genetic mutations that disrupt brain development. It affects 1 in 10,000 girls worldwide and causes severe physical disabilities, communication challenges and learning difficulties.

Poppy's parents were heartbroken. Their hopes for the future of their bright, beautiful daughter suddenly felt lost. Her mum said they have had to "grieve the life we had imagined for her, and probably always will."



Poppy's breakthrough with music

When they heard about Nordoff and Robbins, they felt hopeful but wary. Other activities hadn't helped. But they were willing to try anything that could bring joy back into their lives.

At the very first session, they saw something incredible.

Poppy responded to the music in a way her family had never seen before. The rhythms, the sounds, the act of playing an instrument with a music therapist who was able to reach her through music - it helped her make sense of her world and communicate her feelings.

"In every other situation, Poppy struggled to communicate. But with music, it was different. She was responding to us in ways we didn't think were possible." says Rhiannon.

It even helped Poppy's older sister Charlotte, who had found it difficult to bond with her.

Music therapy gave them a way to connect – to play and enjoy time together.

A new kind of hope

Despite the uncertainty of living with Rett syndrome, music therapy offers Poppy the space for growth and expression, to experience the world in a way that works for her. It keeps her brain and body engaged and helps maintain her abilities for as long as possible.

Music has become a lifeline for Poppy and her family – allowing them to share moments of joy and hope.

"It's more than just therapy," says Rhiannon.


"It's a place where Poppy belongs, and where we can enjoy time together celebrating who Poppy is and creating positive memories together in a way we weren't sure would be possible."

"As parents we all hope our children will find places to thrive and grow and belong- but that often feels unreachable when your child has complex needs. Music therapy offers that vital space, but we need your support to make it accessible for families like ours.
